Although this building would seem to date from an earlier period based on its architectural style, it does not appear on the 1949 Sanborn map. The site previously held a garage, and, earlier, a barn associated with 2500 W. Main St. to the north. The County Assessor supplies a 1951 date of construction, but the building did not appear in city directories until 1959, when it housed the offices of Dr. Richard W. Wells, a podiatrist, and Dr. P.R. Wagner, an optometrist. The building was then addressed as 129 S. Nevada St. Dr. Wells is listed alone in 1961 and is still listed here in 1965.
