8 **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,**  
9 **COLORADO, AMENDING THE CITY CODE, CHAPTER 2**  
10 **DOGS AND CATS OF TITLE 6 POLICE REGULATIONS**

12 **WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Littleton desires to update the Littleton  
13 Municipal Code to reflect changes at state law as well as recently amended areas of our land use  
14 code related to pet limits; and

15  
16 **WHEREAS**, the city council deems it to be in the best interests of the public health,  
17 safety and welfare that the amendments be adopted.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF**  
21 **THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

24 **Section 1:** Chapter 2 of Title 6 of the Littleton City Code is hereby amended as  
25 follows:

27 **6-2-2: RABIES VACCINATION OF CATS AND DOGS:**

28 **A. Unlawful To Own Unvaccinated Cat Or Dog:** It shall be unlawful for the owner of  
29 any cat or dog to fail to have such cat or dog vaccinated against rabies by a  
30 veterinarian licensed to practice veterinary medicine within the state, OR A  
31 **VETERINARY TECHNICIAN ACTING UNDER THEIR DIRECTION AND/OR**  
32 **SUPERVISION**, and revaccinated thereafter on or before the expiration of the vaccine  
33 used.

34 **6-2-10: ACCUMULATION OF ANIMALS:**

35 **B. IT shall be unlawful for any person to maintain on one property in any City**  
36 **residential zone the combined total of more than FIVE (5) DOGS, CATS, OR**  
37 **RABBITS OVER THE AGE OF SIX (6) MONTHS WITH NO MORE THAN**  
38 **THREE (3) BEING OF ANY OF THESE SPECIES.**

39  
40 **Section 2:** Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or

41 phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the  
42 validity of the remaining sections of this ordinance. The city council hereby declares that it would  
43 have passed this ordinance, including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase  
44 hereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or  
45 phrases may be declared invalid.

47 **Section 3:** Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict  
48 with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that this repealer shall not repeal the repealer  
49 clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.
