	Section 1: Chapter 2 of Title 6 of the Littleton City Code is hereby amended as
25 26	follows:

27	6-2-2: RABIES VACCINATION OF CATS AND DOGS:
28	A. Unlawful To Own Unvaccinated Cat Or Dog: It shall be unlawful for the owner of
29	any cat or dog to fail to have such cat or dog vaccinated against rabies by a
30	veterinarian licensed to practice veterinary medicine within the state, OR A
	VETERINARY TECHNICIAN ACTING UNDER THEIR DIRECTION AND/OR
31	
32	SUPERVISION, and revaccinated thereafter on or before the expiration of the vaccine
33	used.
34	6-2-10: ACCUMULATION OF ANIMALS:
35	B. IT shall be unlawful for any person to maintain on one property in any City
36	residential zone the combined total of more than FIVE (5) DOGS, CATS, OR
37	RABBITS OVER THE AGE OF SIX (6) MONTHS WITH NO MORE THAN
38	THREE (3) BEING OF ANY OF THESE SPECIES.

40	Section 2: Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or

phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of this ordinance. The city council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases may be declared invalid.
