Survey #1 Summary

In June and July, over 500 neighbors and users of Ketrington-Gallup Park shared their memories, reflections, and visions for the future of the park through an online survey.

The master plan team is now using the survey responses, feedback taken in person at various community events, and ongoing conversations with stakeholders to inform the creation of a vision for potential improvements for the park. We learned a lot about how important Ketrington-Gallup Park is to the community, and wanted to share those findings with you.

If you didn't get a chance to participate in the first survey, don't worry because a new survey and in-park installation is available until early September, in which you will be able to explore the different areas of the park and tell us what improvements you would like to see in each.

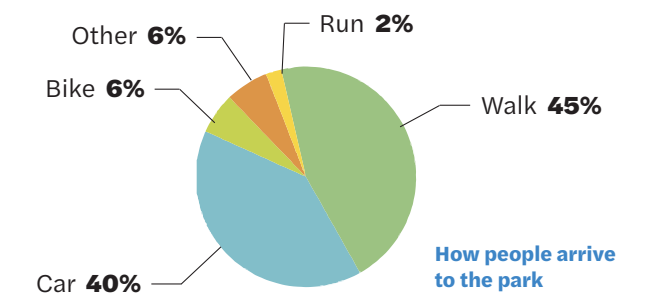
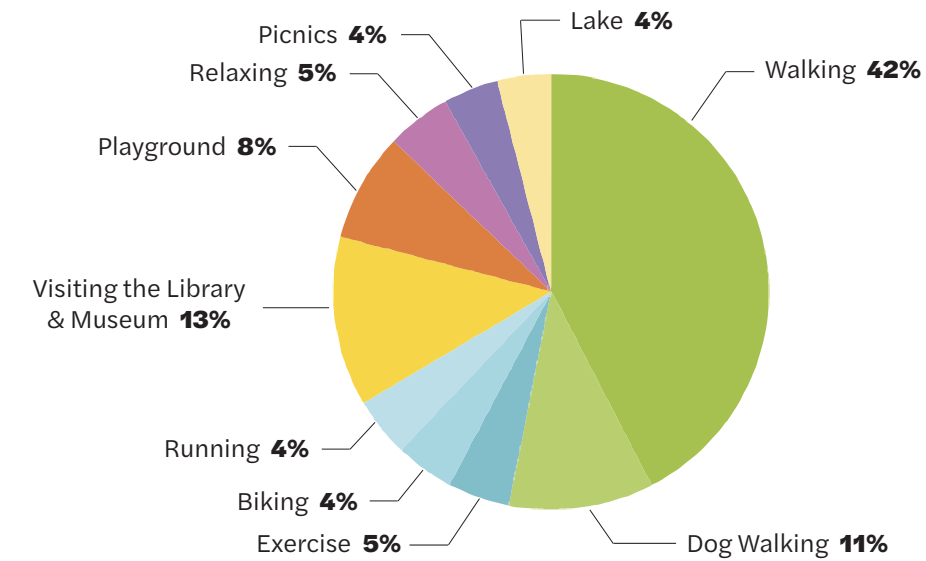
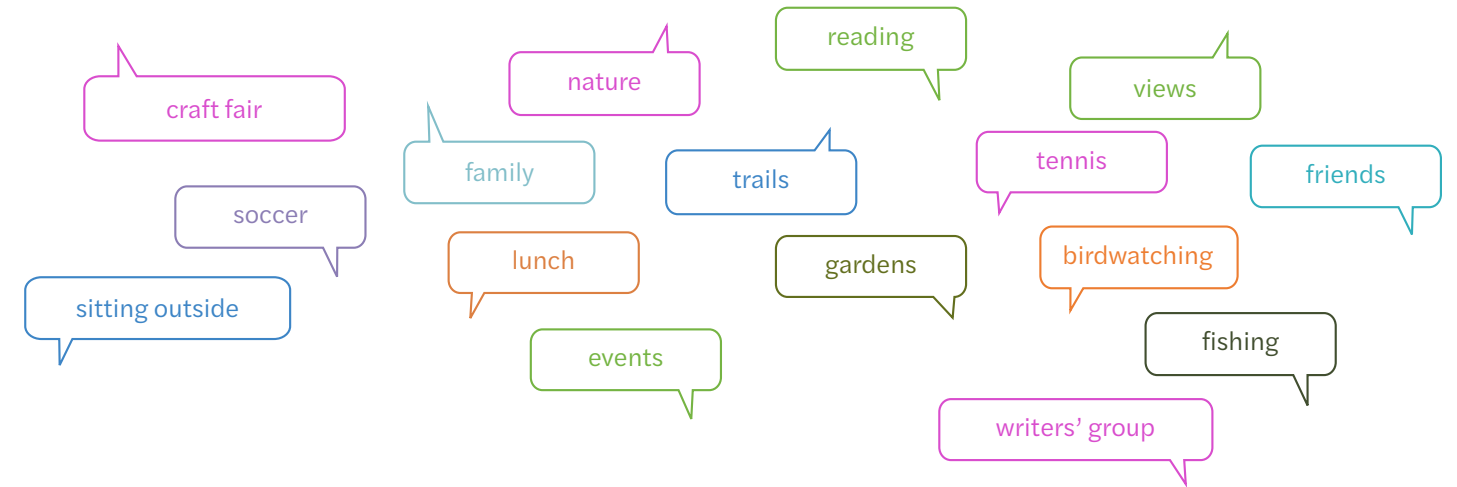


75% of survey respondents live less than a mile away from the park

82% of survey respondents visit the park at least twice a month

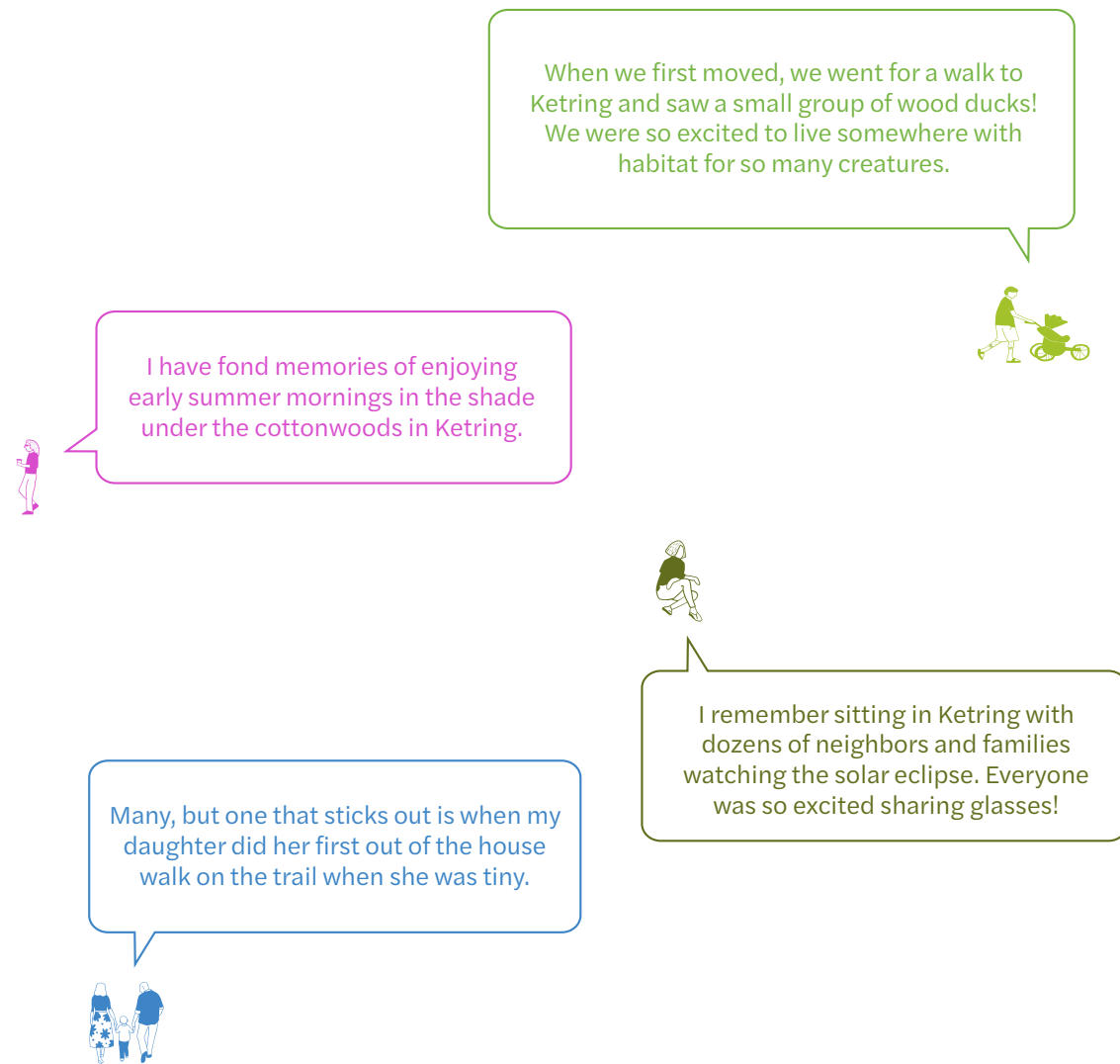
How do you currently use Ketrington-Gallup Park?

Survey #1 respondents use Ketrington-Gallup Park for a variety of different activities and purposes. Walking is by far the most popular activity, which together with other modes of exercise (such as running and biking) makes up over two-thirds of people's primary activity in the park.



What is a particular memory that you associate with Ketrington-Gallup Park?

Survey #1 respondents shared memories of spending time in the park and at the lake with their families, observing wildlife, attending events, and soaking in the nature around them.



How could your experience in the Ketrington-Gallup Park be improved?

Community members and park stakeholders identified a number of needs and wishes for the park. These comments largely centered on desires for more places to sit, more shade, better utilization of underused spaces, and increased park maintenance, as well as concerns over safety and the quality and future of Ketrington Lake.

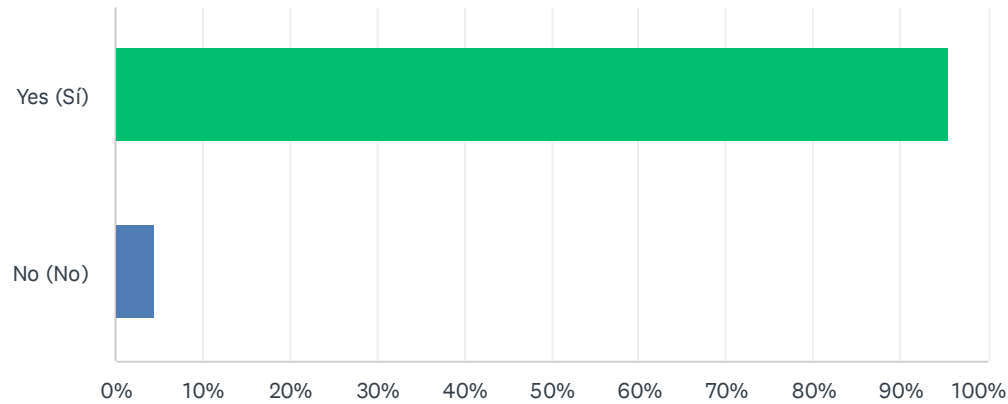

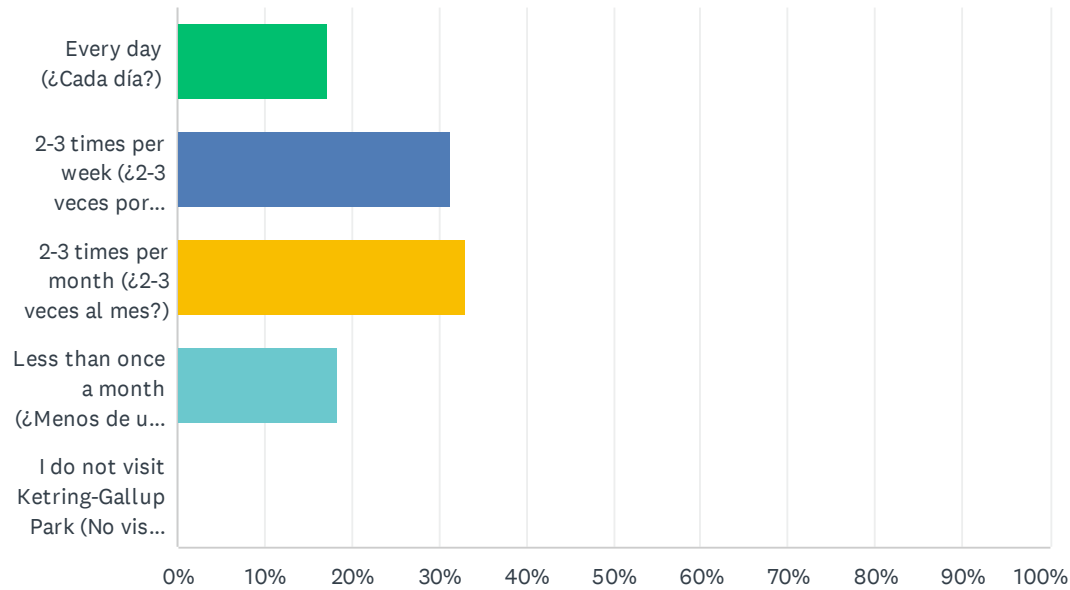

Q3 How often do you visit Ketring-Gallup park? (¿Con qué frecuencia visita el Parque Ketring-Gallup?)

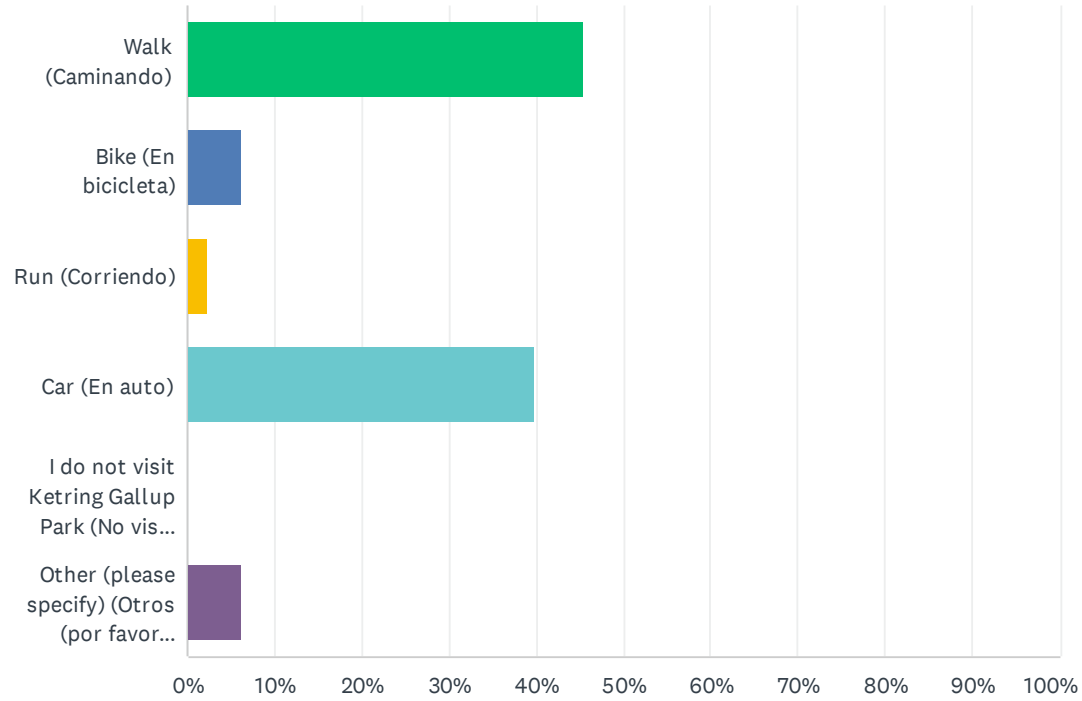

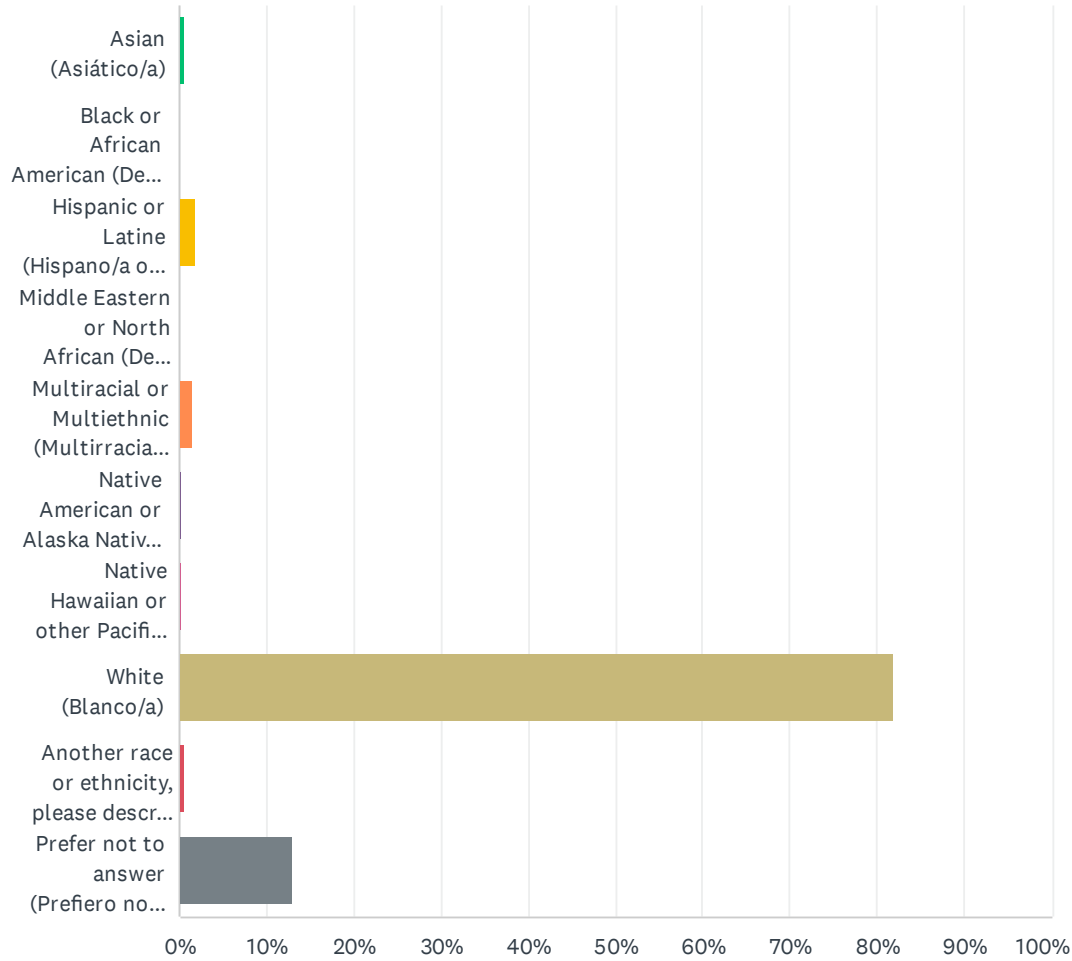
